

Introducing the Archive Wizard in LiveCycle ES2



This is an online bonus article for Chapter 8 of *Paperless: Real-World Solutions with Adobe Technology*. This article details some basic information about the new Archive Wizard in LiveCycle ES2. The new Archive wizard is a tool that helps you create and configure a document archiving process (**Figure 1**). You will make selections in this wizard, and LiveCycle will select and configure the proper operations for your needs. After you click Finish in the wizard, LiveCycle adds the proper operations to your process.

The operations that the wizard adds are standard LiveCycle operations (**Figure 2**) so you can select them and further customize their properties and behavior.

As you saw in this example, LiveCycle Output ES/ES2 is ideal for creating flattened PDF files for document archiving. It is also a useful tool for generating printed documents for on-demand or batch publishing. If your paperless solution requires either of these capabilities, you should further investigate LiveCycle Output ES/ES2.
